Lager/Pilsner

Schloss Eggenberg - Hopfenkonig 330ml, 5.1%, Austria 4.50

Great, easy drinking Austrian lager.

Augustiner - Helles 500ml, 5.2%, Germany 5.20

Full flavoured lager with plenty of lemony citrus and subtle sweetness.

Schneider - Helles Lager 500ml, 4.9%, Germany 5.40

Brilliant old school lager from a "new" brewery.

Fruit Beer

Timmermans - Kriek/Peche 330ml, 4%, Belgium 5.20

Belgian fun! Rich and sweet fruity goodness, cherry or peach?

Bacchus Raspberry 375ml, 5%, Belgium 7.45

Refreshing and balanced raspberry beer that blends fruitiness with traditional oak aged Belgian heritage.

Kasteel - Rouge 330ml, 8%, Belgium 6.35

Kasteel Donker blended with cherry liqueur.

Timmermans - Oud Kriek 375ml, 5.5%, Belgium 7.95

A proper Belgian fruit sour that packs an acidic punch. Natural fermentation process that leaves every brew slightly different.

Belgian/Trappist

Orval 330ml, 6.2%, Belgium 5.30

Orange zest, caramel, savoury spice its all in there. Is this the greatest beer of all time? Its right up there.

Duvel - 6.66 330ml, 6.66%, Belgium 6.30

Lighter and a tiny bit sweeter than it's big brother, Classic Duvel yeast giving bready, banana-esque flavours and earthy, peppery notes.

Tynt Meadow 330ml, 7.4%, England 6.10

Trappist ale, brewed by Cistercian monks in Leicestershire using English malt, hops and barley.

Chimay - Red 330ml, 7%, Belgium 5.45

Amber in colour and full of sweet maltiness this is a cracking example of a proper Belgian Dubbel

Westmalle - Extra 330ml, 4.8%, Belgium 5.45

Fantastic beer only recently available outside of the abbey

La Chouffe 330ml, 8%, Belgium 6.10

The staple Belgian beer. Light and deceptively easy drinking but still packs a nice spicy punch with hints of lemon

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Stout

Dupont - Monk's Stout 330ml, 5.2% Belgium 5.50

Bitter chocolate, coffee and a smoky Irish peatiness

Titanic - Plum Porter 500ml, 4.9% Burslem 5.70

Sweet, plummy, dark and fruity

Wheat Beer

Vedett - White 330ml, 4.5%, Belgium 4.65

Classic, soft, easy drinking wheat beer with a refreshing citrus tang.

Schneider Weisse - Tap 7 Original 500ml, 5.4%, Germany 6.45

Classic, smooth and creamy with notes of cloves and banana.

Cider

Galipette - Cidre Brut 330ml, 4.5% France 4.95

Rich and full-bodied dry french cider.

Kerisac - Cidre Breton 330ml, 5.5% France 4.45

Slightly sparkling, soft and full-flavoured, natural French cider.

Gluten Free

Estrella - Daura Damm 330ml, 5.4%, Spain 4.75

Gluten-free version of Estrella lager, sweet and citrusy.

Arbor - Lager 568ml, 5.2%, UK 5.80

A pint of clean, crisp and hoppy lager.

Burnt Mill - Beyond the Firs 440ml, 4.8% can, England 6.30

Beautifully balanced pale ale with Citra and Centennial.

Alcohol Free/Low alcohol

Jupiler 0.0 250ml, <0.5%, Belgium 3.25

Alcohol free version of their pilsner, lemony, clean and malty.

Rothaus Alcohol Free 300ml, <0.5%, Germany 4.50

Surprisingly realistic alcohol-free version of their pilsner.

Lindeboom - "0.5" 300ml, <0.5%, Netherlands 2.60

Pleasantly fresh, sweet and malty Dutch pale.

Lucky Saint 330ml, <0.5%, England 4.25

Unfiltered lager that packs loads of flavour. We're don't say this lightly but you don't miss the booze.

Until 9pm you can get any of the many beers from Gnome and Away
